Review of data - School Report Card - Utah State Board of Education - shared by Mr. Benson

Our school has a "D" grade. However, we do have a lot of growth and things to celebrate. Achievement is based on the RISE end-of-year test. Our Language arts scores went up by 9.5%, Math showed an increase of 7.6%. Science showed a 1% increase. Growth of our lowest 25% was up 45.8% which is up by 8.3%. English Learners making adequate progress was at 43.4% an increase of 25.1%. Our score was higher than both the district at 36% and the state at 39%. English Learners reaching proficency was 9.4%, an increase of 4.0%. Again, we were higher than both the district at 7% and the state at 5%.

What is Franklin doing differently this year? We are fully staffed with our Instructional Assistants, for the first time in years. Every student in the building is receiving support at their level whether it be remediation or extension. Our teachers and assistants are highly qualified and trained. Teachers are taking their most at risk student groups.

Tuesdays will now be focusing on our PBIS trainings after school from 3:35 to 3:50.
